The Granger Township Board of Trustees met in Regular Session on Monday, October 27, 2025, at 7:00 PM at the Granger Township Administration Building, 3717 Ridge Road. In attendance were Trustees: Richard L. Pace, Chair, John H. Ginley, Jr., Vice Chair, and Teri A. Berry and Fiscal Officer Donald L. Baker.

<u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:</u> The meeting was opened at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance by Trustee Richard Pace.

<u>SHERIFF'S REPRESENTATIVE:</u> Deputy Bryan Barton reported seventeen reported incidents in the Township during October MTD.

Mr. Pace asked about additional policing on Seymour Drive, after complaints were received at the last meeting. Deputy Barton advised targeted enforcement on this road did not yield any speeding violations.

<u>SERVICE DIRECTOR</u> Mark Novak advised a meeting at Culvert #8 on T.H. 48 on Stony Hill Road is scheduled for October 30th. This is one of the culverts that is part of the OPWC project. General maintenance is ongoing.

2026 ROAD WORK PLAN: Mr. Novak recommended we request the Engineer's Office estimate the cost to chip and seal Allard Road (from Bath Road to Remsen Road), Coddingville Road (from Granger Road to Dunsha Road), Stony Hill Road (from Remsen Road to Ledge Road) and State Road (from SR 18 to Granger Road) and motor pave Argyle Lane, Lang Farm Drive and McCarren Drive. Trustees requested Mr. Novak obtain cost estimates from the County Engineer's Office for these roads. Once estimates are received the Board and Mr. Novak will determine a prioritization for road work.

Mr. Novak advised he also plans to request an estimate to chip and seal the Park drive and Parking lot.

Mr. Baker advised the following Resolution is adopted each year to facilitate the purchase of material from the County Engineer.

RESOLUTION 10-27-2025-1: TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MEDINA CO. COMMISSIONERS TO PURCHASE MATERIALS FROM THE COUNTY ENGINEER DURING 2026 was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mr. Ginley, duly seconded by Mrs. Berry.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Granger Township Board of Trustees is hereby signing and entering into an agreement with the Medina County Engineer for the sale/purchase of materials during 2026.

Authorized persons for pick-up and purchase are the Trustees and Township Maintenance Personnel.

The replacement tree is being planted this week.
