The Granger Township Board of Trustees met in Regular	Session on Monday, April 25, 2022, at 7:00 PM at		

the Granger Township Administration Building, 3717 Ridge Road. In attendance were Trustees: John H. Ginley, Jr., Vice Chair and Teri A. Berry and Fiscal Officer Donald L. Baker.

<u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE</u>: The meeting was opened at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance by Trustee John Ginley.

MEDINA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE: A sheriff's representative was unable to attend the meeting. However, Mr. Ginley advised there is a concern with the "Wagon Wheel" property on SR18. It is in extremely poor condition and is reportedly broken into frequently. The Sheriff's office is wondering if there is anything the Township can do about this problem. Zoning Inspector Davis advised there was nothing within the Zoning Resolution that would address this. The ORC provides for a remedy for derelict properties such as this. An address will be needed to commence the procedure.

FIRE DEPARTMENT FIREFIGHTER SWEARING -IN: Mr. Ginley swore in new Firefighter Collin Kalina. Firefighter Kalina was congratulated with a round of applause from the Trustees, Fiscal Officer and audience.

FIRE CHIEF Steve Kamp requested approval to contract with Staley Technologies in the amount of \$2,692.90 for audio repairs to the station radio alerting system. Mr. Baker advised information necessary to establish this vendor has not been received. It was recommended this be deferred until the next meeting.

RESIGNATION OF FIREFIGHTER ELISABETH SUMMERS.: A resignation letter has been received from Firefighter Elisabeth Summers dated April 22, 2022 and effective April 27, 2022.

A MOTION to accept the resignation with regret of Firefighter Elisabeth Summers effective April 27, 2022, was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mrs. Berry, duly seconded by Mr. Ginley.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mr. Ginley and Mrs. Berry.

MEDINA COUNTY ALL HAZARDS TEAM PAYMENT: Approval was requested to pay for \$2,050**Q**0 as the Township's 2022 cost allocation for the County All Hazards Team. Mr. Baker asked if an invoice has been received. It has been received and will be forwarded.

A MOTION approving the County All Hazards Team 2022 cost allocation payment of \$2,050.00, was set forth and moved to be adopted by Mrs. Berry, duly seconded by Mr. Ginley.

Voting "aye" thereon: Mrs. Berry and Mr. Ginley.

<u>APPROVAL OF THEN AND NOW PURCHASE ORDER 49-2022:</u> Mr. Baker requested approval of Then and Now Purchase 49-2022 in the amount of \$13,500.00 to John Deere Financial for fuel. This a result of increased fuel costs; historically monthly charges were under \$1,000.00. This Purchase Order should cover the remainder of the year.

RESOLUTION NO. 04-25-2022-1: APPROVING THEN AND NOW PURCHASE ORDER 49-2022 to John Deere Financial in the amount of \$13,500.00 for fuel and not previously approved was set forth and moved by Mrs. Ginley, duly seconded by Mrs. Berry.

Roll call resulted thusly: Mrs. Berry, aye and Mr. Ginley, aye.

<u>SERVICE DIRECTOR</u> Mark Novak discussed a Resident concern regarding **Reid Hill Road**. The road edge is crumbling. He noted a similar problem on **Coddingville Road**. These problems will be addressed as weather permits.

SEPTIC SYSTEM FAILURE: Mr. Novak advised the cost for a scientist soil review is \$500.00 and the cost of a permit is \$350.00. After the soil analysis, a new septic system will be designed. Mr. Baker noted this may be a permissible expense for ARPA funding.

2022 ROAD WORK: Mr. Baker advised the contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc for the 2022 Road Work Plan has been reviewed by the County Prosecutor's Office and forwarded to us for execution. The plan includes the Motor Pave Coddingville Road (0.50 miles) (\$91,635.30), and Stony Hill Road (1.36 miles) (\$229,556.85) and Longwood Drive (with no fog seal or berming) (0.43 miles) (\$75,848.75) and Chip and Seal of Huntley Drive (0.66 miles) (\$37,824.40) and Rocky Hollow Road (no fog seal) (0.22 miles) (\$17,965.75). The total cost per the bid submission is \$452,831.05. The Board was reminded that Mr. Novak is hoping to reduce the total cost to closer to \$400,000.00, the original anticipated 2022 Road Work Plan budget.

Mr. Davis advised several complaints regarding political signs containing profanity have been received. The Prosecutor's Office has advised there is nothing than can be done about these signs. It is considered a Freedom of Speech issue. Mrs. Gifford said she had contacted the Sheriff's Office about such a sign and was also advised it is a matter of Freedom of Speech.

Mrs. Berry asked how the Zoning Commission meeting went on April 19th. The property owner of 3738 Ridge Road, Medina, OH was unable to attend to continue PDD Preapplication discussions because of travel complications. It is anticipated he will be at the May 10th meeting.

BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS will not meet in April. There may be up to five applications on the May 31st agenda.

ZONING COMMISSION is scheduled to meet May 10th at 7:00 PM to continue PDD Preapplication discussions with the property owner of 3738 Ridge Road, Medina, OH and to continue review of the Zoning Resolution.

SEXTON Roberta Gifford presented quotes for cemetery signs. This will be reviewed and discussed at the next meeting.

Mrs. Gifford discussed a request to install a nontraditional grave stone at Fairview Cemetery. She was requested to get the specifications for review.

GRANGER TOWNSHIP BICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE: Mrs. Gifford advised signs advertising the Bicentennial are being distributed and will go up after the Primary Election. Pig Roast tickets are available.

MEMORIAL DAY: Mrs. Gifford advised we are still awaiting confirmation that there will band participation in our observance. She is working on an alternative plan to have someone lead us in the National Anthem and God Bless America. Scouts will help put flags on veterans' graves.
